City dance group to perform at Little Theatre

CAP Dancemakers will present *Exhibition*, a programme of contemporary dance directed by Sharon Friedman at the Little Theatre, Orange Street from February 12 to 15.

Dancemakers is a semi-professional dance company which has been working together for two years. They have produced a children's programme, *The Owl and the Pussycat*, which enjoyed two successful seasons.

The focus of the group has, however, been on teaching at CAP's Woodstock Centre and particularly in the outreach programmes in Langa and Guguletu.

At the end of 1985, eight classes a week were being taught in Langa and six in Guguletu. The response has been so overwhelming that more are needed and other centres need to be opened.
